

NATIONWIDE WORKFORCE

Per the Bureau of Labor Statistics, as of April 2024 the total private industry payroll-based construction workforce nationally is **8.2 million**, up 4% from 7.88 million last year, showing a consistent year-over-year growth and far surpassing even pre-pandemic employment levels of 7.5 million.

NATIONWIDE IMPACT

Of the Building Congress members surveyed, **68**% of organizations are performing work outside of New York State. Based on the U.S. Census Bureau-designated regions, **43**% of total projects are located in the Northeast. The West follows with **24**% of projects, the South has **22**%, and the Midwest has **12%**.

METHODOLOGY


The New York Building Congress Across America report examines a representative sample of the membership and the range of member projects in all 50 states over the past three years, using a member questionnaire and information from Dodge Data and Analytics.


